from the Pastor's desk

Dear Saint John and Epiphany Parishioners,

Together we have journeyed through the Forty Days following the Resurrection of the Lord from the dead. We have remembered through Holy Scripture the appearances of the Risen Lord to all those whom He chose to be His eye witnesses in the world.

Now, we are celebrating the Solemnity of the Ascension. Having accomplished His work on earth, Jesus departs and commissions us, His Church, in the Gospel today to continue His mission on earth. In fact, He says, "Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you."

I would encourage all of us to spend this coming week as Jesus asked, "... He enjoined them not to depart from Jerusalem, but to wait for the promise of the Father..." In a very real way, Jesus asked them to pray the first Novena; a Novena during these nine days waiting for the coming of the Holy Spirit. This is where our Catholic Tradition of praying novenas comes from! It is directly from the Holy Scriptures by the command of Jesus Himself!

There are many Novenas to the Holy Spirit available. I would suggest going to www.ewtn.com and under the Faith Menu, then Devotions, then Novenas section copying the Holy Spirit Novena and begin praying that Novena tomorrow.

"Then they returned to Jerusalem . . . they went up to the upper room where they were staying. All those with one accord devoted themselves to prayer, together with the women and Mary the Mother of Jesus, and with His brethren."


